An Ordinance to Repeal Wells County Ordinance No. 2001-11, an Ordinance Establishing a County Public Defender Board.

WHEREAS, the Wells County Board of Commissioners established Wells County Ordinance No. 2001-11 to create a county Public Defender Board; and

WHEREAS, the Wells County Board of Commissioners together with the Judges in Wells County, the Wells County Public Defender Board, and some of the public defender, together with other interested parties have met from time to time to review the advisability of being a part of the State's public defender system; and


WHEREAS, all the participants in the meetings have deemed it inadvisable to continue in the State's program.


