

WELLS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2007- 8

An Ordinance Establishing Stop Signs
At the Intersection of
CR 600 East at CR 1050 South

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-9-2-1 et seq. and I.C. 9-4-1-32, as well as several related State statutes, authorize and empower local authorities to establish, maintain, and operate public roads, regulate the use thereof, determine preferential county roads, and place signs to control the traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, desires to change the existing yield signs to stop signs to control traffic at the intersection of County Road 600 East and County Road 1050 South in Wells County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has studied the traffic flow and has determined that, according to all guidelines, the existing yield ahead and yield signs on County Road 1050 South should be removed and STOP AHEAD and STOP signs should be placed on County Road 1050 South at that intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, desires to adopt an ordinance to remove the existing yield ahead and yield signs on County Road 1050 South and place STOP AHEAD and STOP signs on County Road 1050 South at that intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, that:

1. STOP AHEAD and STOP signs shall be placed at the intersection of County Road 600 East and County Road 1050 South stopping traffic on County Road 1050 South.
2. Existing yield ahead and yield signs shall be removed at the intersection of County Road 600 East and County Road 1050 South from County Road 1050 South.
3. Said intersection shall henceforth be designated as County Road 1050 South stopping for County Road 600 East.
4. Motorists shall observe the stop signs in accordance with the direction of the signs posted at the intersection of County Road 600 East and County Road 1050 South.

5. Pursuant to I.C. 9-20-1-4, any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a Class C Infraction.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
