

WELLS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2008-9

An Ordinance Establishing Stop Signs
At the Intersection of
CR 500 West at CR 1000 North

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-9-2-1 et seq. and I.C. 9-4-1-32, as well as several related State statutes, authorize and empower local authorities to establish, maintain, and operate public roads, regulate the use thereof, determine preferential county roads, and place signs to control the traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, desires to remove the existing yield signs and to establish stop signs to control traffic at the intersection of County Road 500 West and County Road 1000 North in Wells County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has studied the traffic flow and has determined that County Road 1000 North will be chip/seal both ways from this intersection while County Road 500 West remains a compacted aggregate surface; and according to all Wells County guidelines the existing yield ahead and yield signs on County Road 1000 North should be removed and STOP AHEAD and STOP signs should be placed on County Road 500 West at that intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, desires to adopt an ordinance to remove the existing yield ahead and yield signs on County Road 1000 North and STOP AHEAD and STOP signs should be placed on County Road 500 West at that intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wells County, Indiana, that:

1. STOP AHEAD and STOP signs shall be placed at the intersection of County Road 500 West and County Road 1000 North stopping traffic on County Road 500 West.
2. Existing yield ahead and yield signs shall be removed from County Road 1000 North at the intersection of County Road 500 West and County Road 1000 North.
3. Said intersection shall henceforth be designated as County Road 500 West stopping for County Road 1000 North.
4. Motorists shall observe the stop signs in accordance with the direction of the signs

posted at the intersection of County Road 500 West and County Road 1000 North.

- 5. Pursuant to I.C. 9-20-1-4, any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a Class C Infraction.
- 6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
