

Wells County Commissioners

Regular Session 7-5-2011

The Wells County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday July 5, 2011 at 9AM in the Commissioner's Room of the Wells County Carnegie Annex, Bluffton, IN. Those in attendance were Commissioners, Paul Bonham and C. Scott Mossburg. Also in attendance were County Attorney, Trent Patterson and County Auditor, Beth Davis. Commissioner Kevin Woodward was absent.

Minutes: Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to approve the minutes from June 20, 2011 meeting. Motion carried 2-0.

Payroll: Commissioners approved Payroll #13 in the amount of \$199,854.65

Claims: Commissioners approved 262 claims in the amount of \$273,980.36

Wells County Sheriff: Monte Fisher reported 78 inmates, 17 are DOC. Sheriff Fisher presented quotes for sealing the parking lot at the Jail. He will be going with Grainger Materials. Sheriff Fisher provided information and quote from Craigville Telephone regarding a solution for the panic button for the Courthouse. The total cost would be \$280.00. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to approve the quote of \$280.00 from Craigville Telephone for the security of panic button for the Courthouse. Motion carried 2-0. Commissioners asked Sheriff Fisher to look into a letter that was received from the Liberty Center South Side Residents regarding concerns they have about the high traffic speeds on 300 West at the South side of Liberty Center.

Wells County Engineer: Larry Owen recommended that commissioners approve the Utility Permit he received from Master Builders for the location at 10603 S 510 W. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to approve the permit. Motion carried 2-0. Larry informed Commissioners that we were not selected for the TEA Project that he had applied for.

Lease for Server: Blake Poindexter asked County Attorney Trent Patterson to look over a lease agreement he received from FPC regarding Leasing a Server for his department instead of buying it. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to have Trent look over the lease agreement. Motion carried 2-0.

Change of Precinct Location: County Clerk, Yvette Runkle asked commissioners to change the polling location for both Ossian East and Ossian West from the Ossian Town Hall to the Nazarene Church in Ossian. The new location has been checked to pass all the requirements of HAVA. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to change the voting location for both Ossian East and Ossian West to the Nazarene Church in Ossian. Motion carried 2-0

Government fixed Asset Services: Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to enter into the agreement with Government fixed asset Services and to have Paul Bonham, Vice President sign the agreement. (Misc 2011-14) Motion carried 2-0

Harrison Township Appeal: Appeal filed by Donna Beavans on 6-23-2011. Donna Beavans does not show. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham, Appellant fails to appear and her appeal is dismissed per IC 12-20-15-5. Motion carried 2-0.

Income Standards for Township Trustee: Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to accept the guild lines for income standards for township trustee in Wells County. Motion carried 2-0.

Family Centered Services: Ginny Fenstermaker, Executive Director for Family Centered Services presented the annual report. Motion made by Scott Mossburg, seconded by Paul Bonham to approve \$10,000.00 annual payment from Wells County to Family Centered Services for budget year 2012. Motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bonham would like to acknowledge and congratulate Miss Sara Alford for being named Miss Indiana State Fair 2011 and how well she has represented her title.
