What's Recyclable and What's Not

Acceptable Items

Paper

Newspaper, paper sacks, magazines, office and computer paper, junk mail, paper board (ex. - cereal boxes, soda boxes, and shoe boxes), and corrugated cardboard and books

Glass

Beer, wine and food jars-**lids removed, jars rinsed**

Metals

Aluminum and bi-metal beverage cans, aluminum foil, baking ware, food cans (**rinsed**), canning lids, metal baking dishes (no non-stick coating), metal food or drink lids, coat hangers

Plastic - #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7

Soda bottles, naturals (milk, juice, water bottles) dishwashing detergent bottles, vinegar bottles, mixed colored containers (laundry detergent or fabric softener containers, bleach jugs or any household cleaner bottles). Flowerpots, bakery, produce containers, any plastics with a recyclable symbol of one of the listed numbers above.

Not Acceptable Items

Paper

Waxed or carbon paper, waxed paperboard milk, juice, or fabric softener refill containers

Metals

Folding outdoor chairs with the webbing still attached, water pumps, engine parts, aerosol cans, etc....

Glass

Window glass, ceramic, candle containers, medical bottles, light bulbs and corning containers

Plastic

Plastic wrap and bags, freezer/food bags, tableware (forks, spoons, etc) dishes or plates, egg cartons, meat or vegetable trays, trays, styrofoam cups, packing "peanuts" or plastic toys

IT IS A TREMENDOUS HELP TO HAVE THE MATERIALS PRE-SORTED - IF POSSIBLE - SEPARATE ALUMINUM CANS AND FOIL FROM ALL OTHER METALS, CORROGATED FROM PAPER!!

PLEASE RINSE OUT ALL CONTAINERS.
