The Wells County Solid Waste Management District met in regular session at 9AM in the Wells Carnegie Annex, Bluffton, Indiana. In attendance were Blake Gerber, Michael Vanover, Chuck King, John Whicker, District Attorney, Colin Andrews and District Controller, Lisa McCormick. Cory Elzey, Jeff Stringer, and Roger Thornton were absent.

Minutes-John Whicker motioned to approve the Regular Session Solid Waste minutes from April 18, 2022, as presented, Chuck King seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Claims-Chuck King motioned to approve 14 claims totaling \$3,706.90, seconded by John Whicker. Motion carried 4-0.

Cash on Hand-Lisa McCormick reported cash on hand of \$259,846.68

Supervisor Report-Recycling Center Supervisor Kevin Poling has been sorting aluminum and tin cans. Process Iron and Metal will pick up gaylord boxes with various metal recycling and submitted a document for approval. Reimbursement will be based on the received dates pricing. A trip fee for pick-up of \$125.00 will be charged. The agreement can be terminated with a 30-day notice. Motion was made by Chuck King, seconded by John Whicker to allow the President to sign the Process Iron and Metal document. Motion carried 4-0.

Confidential Shredding-7,640 pounds of paper was shred for residents on Shred day.

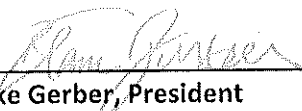
NuGenesis-Hazardous Waste day is June 11th from 8 AM -1 PM.

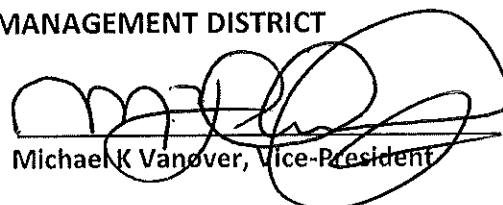
