The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is the focal point for coordination of emergency response and recovery activities throughout. The EOC is the focal point for coordination of Wells County's emergency planning, training, response and recovery efforts. Its processes follow the National All-Hazards approach to such major disasters as fires, floods, earthquakes, acts of terrorism, and large-scale events within and/or affecting Wells County that require involvement by multiple City departments and even regional response agencies.
