WELLS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 24

An Ordinance to Adopt a Rule Home Ordinance Establishing a Health Reimbursement Account Fund

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of the County of Wells ("the Commissioners") recently changed the County employees' health insurance plan, switching from Anthem to PHP, and with that, the employees' former \$3,000 deductible (plus an additional \$1,000 in out-of-pocket expenses) is now increased to \$6,000, but the employees would pay a maximum of \$3,000 before the County would pick up the remaining \$3,000 deductible; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have determined it advisable to establish a County Health Reimbursement Account Fund; and

WHEREAS, under IC 36-1-3-3:

IC 36-1-3-3

Rule of law; resolution of doubt as to existence of power of a unit

Sec. 3. (a) The rule of law that any doubt as to the existence of a power of a unit shall be resolved against its existence is abrogated. (b) Any doubt as to the existence of a power of a unit shall be resolved in favor of its existence. This rule applies even though a statute granting the power has been repealed. *As added by Acts 1980, P.L.211, SEC.1.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WELLS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36-1-3, the Auditor of Wells County shall establish a fund entitled the County Health Reimbursement Account Fund and deposit and invest the County's contributions to the County Health Reimbursement Account Fund.
