These are the soil scientists that have registered with the Indiana State Department of Health and have agreed to consult in Wells County. A soil report from a certified soil scientist is required to obtain a septic permit. *Please follow these instructions:* 

- 1. Contact the soil scientist of your choice to set an appointment.
- 2. Notify the soil scientist if the site is on the *Wabash Recessional Moraine*. Appointments for Wabash Recessional *Moraine* sites must be scheduled Monday through Friday, 8:00 4:30. (Refer to the Moraine Map located on the Health Dept. website or on the Wells County GIS)
- 3. Contact a registered installer (recommended) with a backhoe and laser to be present.
- 4. Notify the Health Department **as soon as the appointment is scheduled,** of the date, location, time and the soil scientist. This is extremely important in the event of a scheduling conflict.
- 5. Submit a copy of the completed "Site Evaluation Form" with the \$25.00 fee to the Health Department and confirm receipt of the soil report.
