Ben also handed out information with pictures of the system that would be installed on the residents' property. The meeting was then opened for questions. There were many questions about easement rights, cost and responsibility that would be incurred by the resident etc. If a resident doesn't sign up within the allotted time frame, the total cost of a future installation may be as much as \$10,000 that the resident will have to pay. Also, residents will have to sign a waiver that they will not remonstrate against annexation. Sandra Houlihan asked why this waiver was necessary requiring people to give up their right to remonstrate. Ben Adams replied that "Historically Speaking" this waiver is required, but not required by law.
